The course consists of three parts

1. Short individual assignment before the meeting in Stockholm
2. Intensive period Stockholm-Nynäshamn-Gotland (May 18th to 23th)
3. Essay writing June-September – examination in Sept 2010 (internet based)

Time for the intensive period Stockholm-Gotland

May 18th 2010, at 13.00: Course starts at Stockholm University

May 19th: Travel to Gotland. Excursions, seminars, lectures – Gotland

May 23rd, at 11.00: Course ends in Visby, Gotland

Costs:

- Doctoral students in Human Geography at Swedish universities participate on the usual conditions for National Research courses. Travel and lodging including excursion fee (= travel and lodging to and on Gotland) below is supposed to be covered by sending university.
- Other participants pay by themselves *travel* to Stockholm and from Visby, and *accommodation* and *living costs* during the time in Stockholm (May 18-19).
- Participants within the Nordic Landscape Research Network can apply for grants covering the travelling and accommodation costs.
- An *excursion fee*, based on lowest costs, will be calculated for the travel to Gotland, travel on Gotland and accommodation on Gotland. The sum will

- depend on the number of participants and will be announced later.
- All participants organise themselves *travel* to Stockholm and from Visby, and *accommodation* during the time in Stockholm.

Send us a few sentences of motivation why you want to attend the course, clarify where you are registered for a doctoral program and please provide a letter of endorsement from your supervisor (clarifying the role of this course in your doctoral program).

If the number of applications will be more than what is feasible for the arrangements priority will be given to 1) PhD students in Human Geography in Sweden, 2) PhD students from universities participating in the Nordic Landscape Research Network.

Confirmation of acceptance will be sent to participants before end of February.
