Power, resistance and landscape

Landscapes are never politically neutral: they are expressions of social, cultural and economic power relations. They are also part of the process of the formation and reproduction of structures of power. This session invites papers that address questions of domination, resistance and contestation in the interpretation of historic landscapes and landscape change. Themes to explore could include class, ethnicity and gender. The session seeks to present critical, historically informed empirical studies. One line of enquiry here could be landscapes of colonialism and imperialism. Papers addressing these issues with material from different parts of Europe are welcome as well as papers addressing the distant past, the recent past or contemporary landscapes.
